Private Michael McGuinn, a native of Baltinglass was killed in the Niamba Ambush in the Congo on 8th Nov. 1960, & Garda Patrick O'Halloran, a native of Gort., Co, Galway was killed in Baltinglass in the line of duty on Jan. 29th 1924. The event will take place as a joint Commemoration Ceremony involving the Defence Forces & An Garda Síochána & the unveiling of a memorial stone in the Square in Baltinglass Town centre. Amongst the invited guests will be an Assistant Garda Commissioner & a representative of the Chief of Staff of the Defence Forces. The event starts at 12pm & blessing will be about 12.30 pm.
