## ST. JOSEPH'S CHURCH OPEN

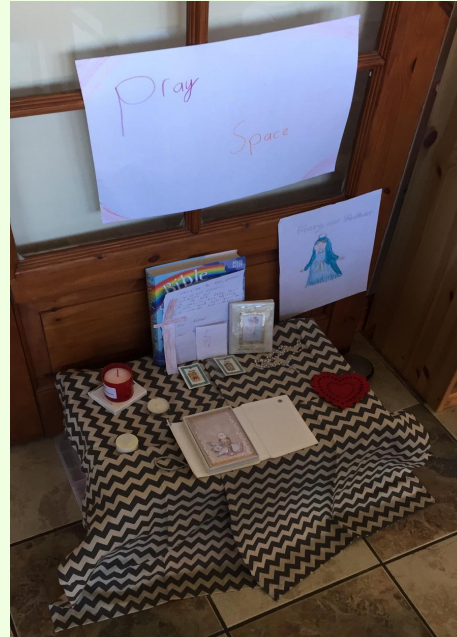
Mon. to Sat. 10am to 4pm      Sunday 12 to 6pm

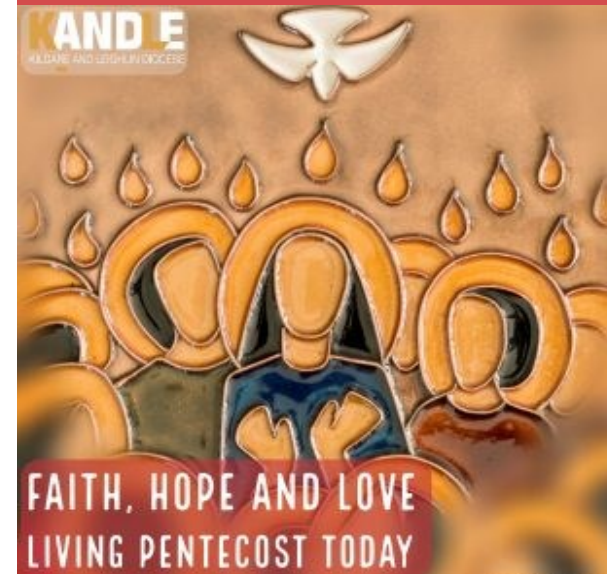
