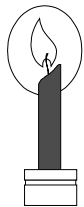

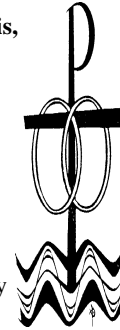

Trinity Sunday.

30th May 2010.

We are all invited to give and receive love and maybe cannot for one reason or another. Today is Trinity Sunday and the Trinity God - the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, are each of them love.
