Prayer at the Ploughing 2019

At a recent launch of Prayer at the Ploughing challenge, I remarked on the most recent census where over 85% of respondents said they had a religious affiliation. In the seven weeks leading up to the Ploughing Championships, I am asking people all around the diocese to choose the prayer they like most, such as the Rosary or the Lord's Prayer. Perhaps a prayer learnt at their mother's knee or handed down ó ghlúin go glúin in their family.

The Ploughing Championships takes place in the middle of the annual Season of Creation, which the Church marks from 1 September – 4 October. Because the 3-day ploughing championship focuses on rural living, I am also inviting people to submit a personal prayer (no more than 100 words) about the environment which they compose themselves. This new environmentally centred prayer could relate to farming, gardening or sustainability.
