Would you like to give a break in your home to an adult with an Intellectual Disability? Home Sharers provide a break in their own homes to adults with an Intellectual Disability. This enables them to enjoy a break or holiday in a friendly home atmosphere. It provides opportunities for adults with an Intellectual Disability to become more independent, develop new relationships, build on their social skills, widen their horizons and have new experiences. It gives families a break from the constant care and responsibility. The home sharing host family have a chance to learn more about disability while caring for the adult in their home. Each host family will have a social worker who will visit by arrangement or on request to discuss any issues which may emerge. The Social Worker will provide support and advice if needed. There is an allowance to host families who participate in Home Sharing. This money is to defray any added expense.
