PARISH WEBCAM

New cameras have been installed in the Oratory and St. Joseph's Church. Some adjustments have yet to be made. Logging in details have also changed.

To log on

www.baltinglassparish.ie/webcam

Or just type into the search box: BALTINGLASS PARISH WEBCAM

What comes up on the screen will look different from before.

Select whichever applies at the time—St. Joseph's Church or St. Paul's Oratory and then click on the arrow on the black screen.
