CHRISTMAS MASSES

As numbers permitted in the church are limited under Covid 19 restrictions and in the interest of health and safety admittance will be by ticket only.

- Tickets will be allocated in the Office
- Tickets will be available for collection on and from Tuesday 15th from the Parish Office and at Masses on the weekend of 19th/20th December
- Remaining tickets will be allocated, on a first come first serve basis, by calling in person to the Parish Office from Tuesday 15th
- Maximum of 5 tickets per family
- As we will not be able to accommodate everyone in the church we encourage people to come to Mass and view it or listen to it while remaining in their cars. Holy Communion will be brought to you.
