PLEASE SUPPORT IMPROVEMENTS TO OUR PARISH COMMUNICATION

In the past 12 months we have upgraded all these facilities at a total cost of $\leq 12,617$. The radio transmitter (≤ 1967) had to be replaced in February (just in time for lockdown). Cameras (≤ 6905) were upgraded. Giving much better pictures from the church and oratory. The parish website (≤ 3745) was redesigned and the STRIPE facility for making donations on-line was added.

This has been a significant outlay but a very necessary one for the times we are living in. We are also doing this when parish income is much reduced. (Church collections were down by c. \leq 50,000 last year.)

FAMILY PRAYER


Take some time to pray as a family, perhaps around the table after the evening meal.
