



3rd Sunday of Lent

7th March 2021

'I will pour clean water on you and wash away all your sins!'

My Aunt Breda made a doll for herself when she was a child out of potatoes and matchsticks. This was because she had no doll.

Today's Gospel is powerful and is surprising because yes - Jesus got angry. Most of us have experienced anger at some stage - maybe anger directed towards us from others or our own anger directed at some one else or anger turned towards us from someone else or anger turned towards myself. Now Jesus got angry in the Temple - the place of worship - a reminder that each of us has a place of worship within.

Just as Jesus anger in the Temple was a cleansing so also do I need to cleanse my inner temple. Each day I need to bring myself before God to allow him to clean me up - in my thoughts, my words my actions. He does this with his love for me - His child. My biggest problem is forgiving myself. Each day I need to turn over a new leaf and have a fresh start, letting go of yesterday. Lent - a time for repentance (feeling regret), a time for making new. This Lent let me be grateful for all I have, for all I've been given.

Aunty Breda was creative making a doll for herself and at 16 years she went to work in America and the first thing she bought with her first wages was a doll.
