to the church.

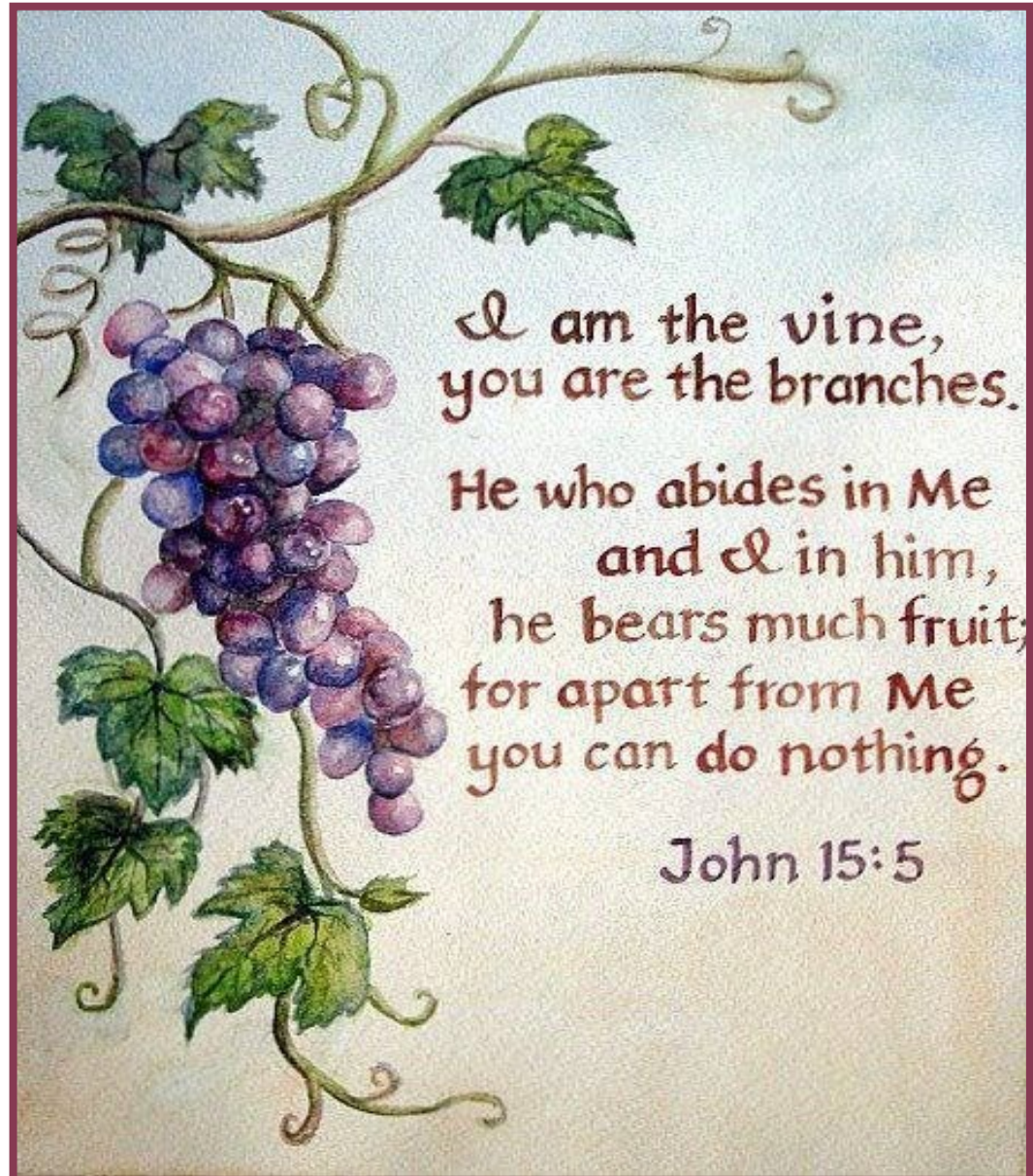
