"It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the Kingdom of God". (Mk 10)

Letting go... this is the season of letting go...the trees are gradually changing colour and some trees have already let go of their leaves. For them there is no struggle in the letting go.

The Gospel today says:

"go and sell everything you own...then come follow me". Jesus is talking about my attachment to everything and everyone. He is asking us to let go freely just as the trees do. I can be attached/clinging to my ornaments, jewellery, photographs, opinions, achievements...

"It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." Attachment is the enemy of love. Only in freedom can I love a person. I need to stop everything...and let go...and allow the Spirit in my heart to work in and through me. This is the Kingdom of God within.

The deepest part of me wants to live an authentic life - not just to impress others - not just living a game, but living honesty, sincerity and respect with others. In the reading from Hebrews it says: "everything is uncovered and open to the eyes of God" God already knows. He is not a Judge. I need to let go of anything false in myself. The first reading speaks of the 'Spirit of Wisdom' and the nature of wisdom is that it unites, so perhaps this Autumn I can unite/ join with the trees in letting go - in a total surrender so that you will.
