BAPTISM OF THE LORD

"As soon as Jesus was baptized in the river Jordan, the heavens were opened & the Holy Spirit alighted on him like a dove, as a voice from heaven said: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Mt 3:17).
