

'I am who I am' 'This is my name for all time'.



Did you ever lock the car or switch off the cooker and later wonder to yourself if you had actually done just that?

Well, I have many a time. I find it's a good idea to say to myself: 'I am switching off the cooker,'

'I am locking the door' as I do the task.

In today's first reading, God tells Moses his name 'I Am who I Am'. His name is not I was or I will be but is God of the present moment. 'I Am'. We are all invited to live in the moment, to let go of the luggage of the past, to live an original life just as Jesus did.

Christianity is meant to lead us into freedom, not to keep us bound up. Christ did not imitate anyone. He was a revolutionary person.
