21st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

'Try your best to enter by the narrow door' (Lk 13)

Going into football matches often times you have to go in through a turnstile which can be very narrow. This will give you some idea of today's gospel which says 'Try your best to enter by the narrow door'. I immediately had images of myself trying to drag in suitcases and luggage that wouldn't fit through and of myself trying to loose weight so I'd make it through the narrow door. Somehow I'd have to fold myself up to get through the door to the kingdom of heaven.

This is a great image because I realise I'm not to acquire anything, not to accumulate baggage, status or power nothing - and not trying to be someone or something I'm not, not trying to be perfect, dropping all the 'weights of the world' for my yoke is easy and my burden is light'. I must get rid of all the interior weights - anything that holds me back. The gospel says 'Many will try to enter and will not succeed'. Just imagine yourself clinging on to some belongings or some aspects of yourself, to ideas, beliefs, to people, to ego, going through the narrow door. Everything is left behind—I'm naked spiritually before God if I want to enter, also naked before myself.

The narrow door is the interior way for each individual the doorway to the centre of the heart. And the most beautiful aspect of this is, that when I take that route I'm taking it for the whole of creation. A.S.




