THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

"Do you love me?" is the question Jesus asked of Peter and now asks of the one who will be

Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love me?" as recorded in the Gospel for the Third Sunday of Easter. This happened while Jesus was having breakfast with His disciples after His resurrection. Jesus used this moment to encourage Peter about his future responsibilities and even to prophesy how Peter would die. By repeating the question, "Do you love me?" three times, Jesus was stressing the importance of Peter's love and unwavering obedience as crucial for his future ministry.

Each time Peter answered, "Yes," Jesus told him to feed His sheep. This meant that if Peter truly loved Jesus, he was to care for and lead the people who belonged to Him. Jesus' words highlighted Peter's role as the leader of the new Church in Jerusalem, responsible for spreading the gospel throughout the world.

Top Ten Ways to Help Pollinators: Manage and plant native hedgerows for biodiversity

The more blossom your hedgerow has in Spring, the better it is for biodiversity. Allow hedges to grow into a natural A-shape profile rather than a neat box shape.

Why: Native hedgerow plants such as Hawthorn (also called Whitethorn), and Blackthorn flower early in Spring, providing vital food for wild bees when they emerge from hibernation. Birds and mammals eat
