6th Sunday of Easter - 25th May 2025

In John's Gospel for the 6th Sunday of Easter, which we read today, Sunday, May 25th, Jesus is saying farewell to his disciples as he prepares to meet his Death, Resurrection, and Ascension (which we will celebrate next Sunday) – his passage to the Father. He gives them the gift of Peace. Peace – Shalom (in Hebrew) is the great gift of the Risen Christ.

"Peace, I leave with you; my own peace I give you!"

When Pope Leo XIV was elected, he wished all the people of Rome, who had assembled, the Peace of the Risen Christ.

"Peace be with you all!" the new Pope announced after waving to the huge crowd who came to joyfully greet him. "Dear brothers and sisters, these are the first words spoken by the risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for God's flock. I would like this greeting of peace to resound in your hearts, in your families, among all people wherever they may be. ... Peace be with you!

"It is the peace of the risen Christ. A peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. A peace that comes from God, who loves us all unconditionally."

Let us persevere, despite hardship and difficulty, to be messengers of peace no matter the contrary voices we hear in our world today. Let our peace be the inner peace of Jesus, which comes from what he did, "I love the Father, and I am doing exactly what the Father told me." Jesus' unconditional trust in God the Father is the source of his deep, inner peace...a peace deeper than suffering or any temptation. Let us remember that in God's will is our peace.
