SUMMER MONTHS - SUMMER HOLIDAYS

Over the past week the Parish Office sent out a letter to the Parents of our First Holy Communion Children and our Confirmation Candidates for 2026, through the kindness of the schools before they closed for the Summer Holidays. In this letter each family was invited to start thinking about weather they wish to have their children receive their next initiation sacrament; First Holy Communion (2nd Class) or Confirmation (6th class Baltinglass & Bigstone or 5th & 6th class Stratford & Grangecon) respectively.

Parents were reminded of the responsibility they undertook at their child's Baptism, to share their faith with their child. They were asked to reflect on how they have done this and how important it is for them to remain connected with our wider faith community by coming together with their children to our liturgical services and masses and taking an active participation. Sharing our faith publicly is a reflection and an integral part of our own personal relationship with Jesus, responding to his call for us to go into the world and be "Jesus" for everyone we encounter.

Celebrating the Sacraments of Confession / Frist Holy Communion and Confirmation, once again gives us all an opportunity to recommit ourselves to be active members of our Parish. In Baptism we are all God's children, in Confession / Frist Holy Communion we know that we are loved and always forgiven of our sins, and we can participate fully in the mass, receiving the food of life, Jesus's body and blood. Then in Confirmation we are all filled with the grace and gifts of the Holy Spirit giving each of us the courage and strength to fulfil the mission we have as follower of Christ in the Spirit of Synodality.

The same mission that we celebrate today in the Solemnity of Ss. Pater and Paul, Apostles. Peter, a fisherman who became leader and the rock on which the Church is built. Paul, who became the 'Apostle of the Gentiles'. Both proclaimed with their lives that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.




