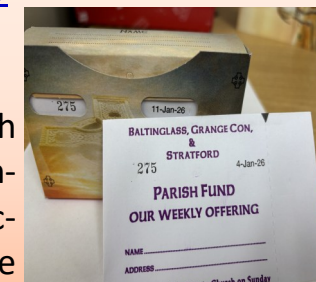

PLEASE CONSIDER USING OUR OFFERTORY

BOX SET

Many families in our parish use the Parish Offertory Box Set, which is a box of small envelopes for each Sunday and special collection. Instead of putting loose cash in the basket at Mass, you can put your donation in the marked envelope at home and bring it to church. Each box has a number linked to your name, and only the parish office keeps this information safely for communication purposes.



Using the Parish Offertory Box Set helps the parish get extra money through the government's tax refund scheme called 'Tax Relief for Donations to Eligible Charities'. If your total donations for the year are €250 or more (that's just €5 a week), the parish can claim back an additional €112.32 from Revenue at no extra cost to you. It's an easy way to support the parish and make your donation go further. All you need to do is fill out a simple form, which the parish will send you, to allow us to claim the tax refund.
